Transition Town Llandovery

Mick Davies is creating a Transition group in Llandovery and came along to introduce himself to the group. We will give whatever support we can.

Twmpath

John has spoken to Annie who has volunteered to help organise this provided it takes place in September. Steve has volunteered to help too.

Eco-homes tour

John has spoken to Eurgain Powell who is flexible about the approach to documenting the tour. **Steve to put Pat's report on website.**

Film

John has spoken to Llangadog Film Club who are happy to loan equipment to us. They couldn't commit to a joint venture without knowing what the film will be.

It is proving hard to find a film which would attract a large enough audience to make it a genuine fundraiser.

Provisions Market

Gwalia are expected to appeal against being turned down for the redevelopment. The Provisions Market group is in the process of putting together a business plan.

Cornwallis Estate, Llanwrda

Pat pointed out that the latest edition of The Post has an article about a consultation exercise launched by the Trustees of the Cornwallis charity. They need to raise £200,000 for the house alone, and additional funds for the improvement and maintenance of the field and grounds, or allow the house to be sold on the open market. Alongside the fundraising option they outline a vision of the field and outbuildings being used for an education centre and a communal garden. A questionnaire is available from the Old Post Office Llanwrda until 12th May. Some of us agreed to collect and complete forms.

Steve will pass information about the Adfer Ban a Chwm group to Pat. This group is also concerned with revitalising rural areas by refurbishing existing buildings.
